Professor Chris Cooper is Professor in the department of Business and Management in the Faculty of Business at Oxford Brookes University, UK. Professor Cooper was Dean of the Faculty from 2009-2013. He is the author of a number of journal papers and books in the field and was awarded the United Nations Ulysses prize for contributions to tourism education and policy in 2009.
