- Pricing in holiday rentals and other accommodations
- Sentiment analysis through users' comments in websites as Tripadvisor, Booking.com and Airbnb
- Car sharing and other forms of collaborative consumption in the transport sector
- Evolution and importance of free-tour services nowadays
- Innovative uses of sharing economy and collaborative consumption in the tourism sector (e.g. immersive local experiences).
- Other forms of non-profit and/or commercial sharing economy as home sharing, coworking, local community markets, etc.
